# WESTON LAMBERT statement



My most recent work utilizes glass and stone to document the passing of time. The layers of stone in my sculptures represent geological sedimentation as a natural record of time, while the layers of glass mark an accumulation of time in relation to human history and archaeology. By sculpting with a combination of glass and stone, I create a document of the persistence of time and its passage through the sedimentation of both nature and civilization.

The strata in my work also signify the accumulation of experiences during a lifetime. These layers function as a foundation from which we acknowledge the past and navigate the present.
